

Contestants for the title of **Mx.** 1000 Islands Pride Inc., **Ms.** 1000 Islands Pride, Inc, and **Mr.** 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. must be at least 19 years of age; live in the Ontario region, and identify as a member of LGBTTQ2+ community.

Deadline to register: Midnight Saturday May 11, 2019

Dates of Pageant: Meet and Greet May 26, 2019 from 2pm to 4pm at the Royal Theatre 75 King Street East Gananoque, On. K7G 1E8 – all contestant should be there to meet the public.

Pageant Competition: May 26, 2019 at the Royal Theatre – 75 King Street East, Gananoque, On. K7G 1E8 starting promptly at 7:30 p.m. All pageant contestants should arrive **no later than** 6:00 p.m.

Mr.

Mr. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. performers identify as a member of the LGBTQ2+ community and are portraying a male gender expression throughout the entire night of the pageant.

Ms.

Ms. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. performers identify as a member of the LGBTQ2+ community and are portraying a female gender expression throughout the entire night of the pageant.

Mx.

Mx. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. performers are not required to identify with the gender binary nor are they asked to portray a specified gender expression. Instead, they are encouraged to present themselves and perform the way they feel most comfortable.

REGISTRATION FEE:

The registration fee will consist of the following:

Registration fee for the Pageant is \$75.00 which must be paid in full at the time of the registration by e-transfer only. E-transfer can be made to email account ceo@1000islandspride.ca. Once payment is received, the candidate will receive confirmation by email.

Deadline to register is May 11, 2019. Applications must be emailed to pageant@1000islandspride.ca and info@1000islandspride.ca and must be received no later than Midnight on May 11, 2019.

Rules and Regulations

Judging will be based on a total point accumulation system. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. will supply all of the official scoring documents to the judges prior to the pageant.

1. No performer can hold the title of Mr., Ms. or Mx. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. for more than 2 consecutive years. Winners of these titles may compete after another performer has held the title for 1 year.
2. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. will review all applications and select the top 7 applicants to participate in the pageant for the category they have selected. Contestants for the title of Mr., Ms. and Mx. 1000 Islands Pride will be judged in the following categories:
 - a. Evening wear/ Runway walk,
 - b. A 2-minute speech,
 - c. 2 Talent Numbers,
 - d. A question by the host for each category and
 - e. Miss Congeniality will be voted by the attendees at the pageant.
3. The use of or the dispensing of any illegal substances will not be tolerated and will be grounds for **immediate** removal from the pageant. Consumption of alcohol before or during the Pageant may result in removal from the competition if the contestant is deemed inebriated.
4. Talent presentations will be limited to five (5) minutes. No score will be given if the talent presentation runs longer than the time allowed. All talent presentation songs shall be sent to pageant@1000islandspride.ca email address. Contestant should also bring, as a backup, a high quality MP3 or USB labeled with your name and presentation number.
5. Prop setup will be included in your overall allotted time of 5 min for your talent. Please keep this in mind when choosing your talent number. Points will be deducted from your score if the set-up takes longer than the time given.
6. Any talent presentation will be acceptable, except those presentations that may cause harm to others. Any comment or presentation that is deemed unacceptable will result in a disqualification from the pageant.
7. Any contestant caught in the act of stealing will immediately be disqualified and removed from the pageant venue.
8. Any contestant whose actions or comments are deemed demeaning or are deemed as offensive, such as racist, homophobic, transphobic or misogynist etc. to the title of Mr., Ms. or Mx. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. will be disqualified.
9. Any contestant who is late or who does not participate in all pageant activities will have points deducted from their final score.

10. Please remember that punctuality is a must in this pageant and, all contestants are expected to arrive at the venue 2 hours prior to the start of the event.
11. All contestants must bring their own supplies, make-up etc. with them to the pageant venue. All contestants are required to arrive at the pageant and check in no later than 7:00 p. m. Pageant will begin promptly at 9:00 p.m.
12. All contestants are required to remain at the pageant venue during the pageant.
13. All contestants must agree to follow the standards of conduct for Contestants and Titleholders.
14. All contestants for the title of Mr., Ms. and Mx. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. must be willing to fulfill the Titleholder Mandate and, the runner-up must be willing to take over the responsibilities should the titleholder be unable for any reason to complete their reign.
15. Please note that any breach in these regulations will result in your immediate disqualification from the pageant.
