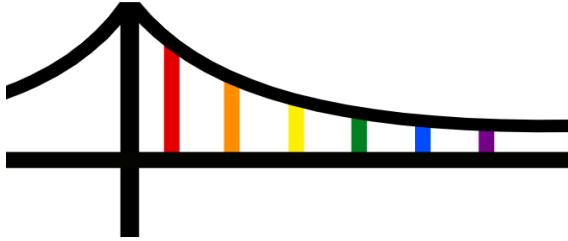

Pageant Titleholder Mandate and Contract Between And 1000 Islands Pride, Inc.

As Ms.; Mr., or Miss. of 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. I will be expected to meet certain benchmarks and obligations during my year as Pride Ambassador.

In order to assist in this, the following mandate will help to ensure that the titleholder obligations are met. **Over my year I “ _____ ” will:**

- Be required to attend the 2021 and 2022 Pride events, to be held at the Town Hall Park on King Street East, Gananoque, On. and other events following the Pageant organized by 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. The winner of each category will be required to attend several events during Pride week of July 2022 including the Arts Festival, Meet & Greet, Parade, and other events as per our guide and at the request of 1000 Islands Pride, Inc until a new coronation takes place in 2023.
- Make community appearances in support of various LGBTTQ2+ organizations.

- Attend or participate via video conference or in person (if possible), the regular meetings when requested.
- The winner in each category will also be required to raise awareness and funds for 1000 Islands Pride, Inc by **completing 3 fundraising events in Gananoque, Ontario**. The fundraising events must be approved by 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. Board of Directors and, the Executive Team.
- The winner (s) of the previous year will be expected to perform at the following years' pageant for the passing of the title and crown.

In addition to the above-mentioned benchmarks, I agree to hold the title of **Ms. Mr. or Miss**. 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. organization, and all partners in the highest esteem. While representing the title, 1000 Islands Pride, Inc., Pageant titleholders agrees to the following while representing their title:

- Titleholders will present themselves professionally at all times while representing the title and while wearing the Pride Sash and/or Crown (both onstage and off-stage).
- Titleholders may be requested to attend and/or participate in a variety of community events and to make regular appearances in support of the 1000 Islands Pride, Inc. and other community organizations.
- Titleholders shall appear in their Pride Sash and or Crown while representing 1000 Islands Pride, Inc.
- Titleholders shall be totally responsible for the safeguard of all pageant jewelry given to him/her during the year. Failure to safeguard said property will result in a \$200.00 fine, removal from the titleholder position and possible legal action.
- Titleholders may reign for up to two consecutive years and must wait until someone else has held the title for a full year to be eligible to re-enter the competition.

In the event that the Titleholder is unable to complete their reign or in the event of a breach in the contract, the titleholder shall forfeit all of their prizes, tiara and/or crown, and sash **immediately**.

The First Alternate for each category shall be available, for the first 3 months of the newly appointed Titleholder reign, to take over should the winner be unable to fulfill their duties. The First Alternate will only be able to refuse the title after the 3-month period has passed.
